### Students Feedback Analysis

### Summary

Student's feedback analysis is conducted in online and offline mode. The majority of students have positive perception of various aspects of the curriculum, teaching methods, learning resources, assessment and practical sessions. They find the curriculum objectives clear, courses well organized, and workload manageable. Student willingly attend classes and shows active participation in conductive learning environment. They also appreciate the quality of learning resources and find the pace of courses appropriate. Feedback on assessments is considered helpful, and core subject teaching is highly regarded. Tutorials and practical sessions are seen as effectively handled and valuable. While there are some uncertainties and a small percentage of disagreement, and the overall feedback indicates a positive student experience in these areas.

In terms of Curriculum, more than 90 % of students are strongly agrees and agree with the clarity of objectives, organization of courses and workload manageability. Similarly 92 % of students are satisfied and agrees about the effectiveness of teaching methods and conducive learning environment and with the assessment. Regarding learning resources, less than 10 % are uncertain about their quality and availability and less than 5 % disagrees with their effectiveness. Concerning the pace of courses and efforts made by staff, less than 10 % of students expressed uncertainty and disagreement with the aspect.

In relation to assessment feedback, less than 10% of students are uncertain about its helpfulness, and with the assessment methods. For core subject teaching, more than 95% of students are strongly agrees about the punctuality of the instructor organization of content and delivery mechanism in tutorials and practical sessions less than 10 % of students express uncertainty with their effectiveness and usefulness.

#### Action taken:

While the overall feedback is positive, these disagreements and uncertainties highlight areas where some students have reservations or lack clarity. TEC takes necessary steps to address.






