### Sports Process & Policies

#### 1. Process of Intra/Inter sports event organization & participation

As per AICTE/University circular every year student's council have been formed. Councils all posts have been selected by interviewing the eligible students by the panel (HOD, All faculty events in -charges, Faculty members). In this the three posts Sports secretary & 2-deputy secretary have been selected then following procedure have been adopted for Inter/Intra sports Organization & participation

Under the guidance of faculty Sports Incharge, Members & Gymkhana Incharge following process have been adopted for Intra / Inter sports event organization & participation.

1. As per students council selection process Two students will be selected as sports secretary & deputy sports secretary, who will take care of student coordination, organization of sports events & Intra / Inter sports events participation.
2. Selection of icon player from each Dept. will be processed by student's sports secretary.
3. Icon player will take care of selection of team from his or her dept. from which he or she belongs for participation in Intra / TPL sports event participation.
4. For sports event organization students organizing committee / Event heads committee will be formed for proper coordination & best performance of the sports events.
5. Every year 4 - days Intra / TPL sports events have been arranged. Within these four days Indoor & outdoor sports have been organized.
6. This Intra college sports events we are felicitating the Winner & Runner-up team by presenting Trophies, Medals, Certificates & cash prizes.
7. Inter sports events participation, College level individual sports Teams have been formed by selecting the best player from each sports events from various dept.
8. Official TEC sports Teams will represent the college in various sports events by participating in various Inter sports events. All teams expenditure care have been taken by TEC as per the TEC sports policies.

## 2. TERNA ENGINEERING COLLEGE TURF / GYMKHANA POLICIES:

- Terna Engineering College (TEC) official team will be allowed to play on turf on the regular basis for 2 hours.
- Students interested other than official team can collect the passes from gymkhana to play on turf.
- Turf will only be allotted for 1 hour for regular students other than official team
- No permission will be given for any sports routine practice in the college campus other than turf.
- Timing for TURF & Gymkhana facility are 8:00 am To 4:00 pm. Except Public Holidays & Saturday, Sunday's.
- For indoor games official teams can play for 2 hours in gymkhana and other than official team students will be permitted for 1 hour to play.
- For inter college sports competition procedure should be followed through the proper channel for the authentication of the team for participation.
- The above procedure should be followed prior to the 15 days before the event schedule.
- Without the authentication no team will be permitted officially to participate in any inter college sports event.
- For participating in inter college sports event the consent form is mandatory and it should be signed by the parents/guardian and should be reached to sports committee in charge before going to competition.
- Thrice in a year individual sports event team will be permitted to participate inter sports competition.
- No permission will be given to any Sports participation before one week of university Examination or during University Examination.

11. TEC sports Incharge, Gymkhana incharge & Students sports secretaries are taking care of all sports inter/intra sports activities organization & participation. All faculty sports members with coordination of above sports Member Event Incharges taking care of their individual sports events & procedure of participation of students in various sports events. All expenditure of all sports Inter & Intra event Registration, Travelling, Food, & Residence if required & TEC Sports Events Organising (SPORTEC) TEC management always takes care positively.

After the event got over, it left the footmarks of the joy and happiness of the crowd and so the overwhelming occasion by Cultural Committee came to an end.



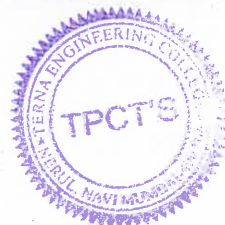
