The final buzzer round added an element of excitement, testing not only recall but also reflexes and the ability to perform under pressure.

Quiz Format & Marking Scheme:

- **Round 1: Tech Trivia**

Description: Participants answer simple, tech-based questions on given topics.

Difficulty Level: Easy

Marking Scheme:

Correct Answer: +10 points

Wrong Answer: 0 points (no penalty)

- **Round 2: Code Decode**

Description: Participants spot and fix errors in simple code snippets displayed on the screen.

Difficulty Level: Medium

Marking Scheme:

Correct Answer: +10 points

Wrong Answer: -5 points

- **Round 3: Buzzer Round**

Description: Tech-based questions are asked, and participants must press the buzzer to answer.

Difficulty Level: Medium

Marking Scheme:

Correct Answer: +10 points

Wrong Answer: -5 points


Outcome:
