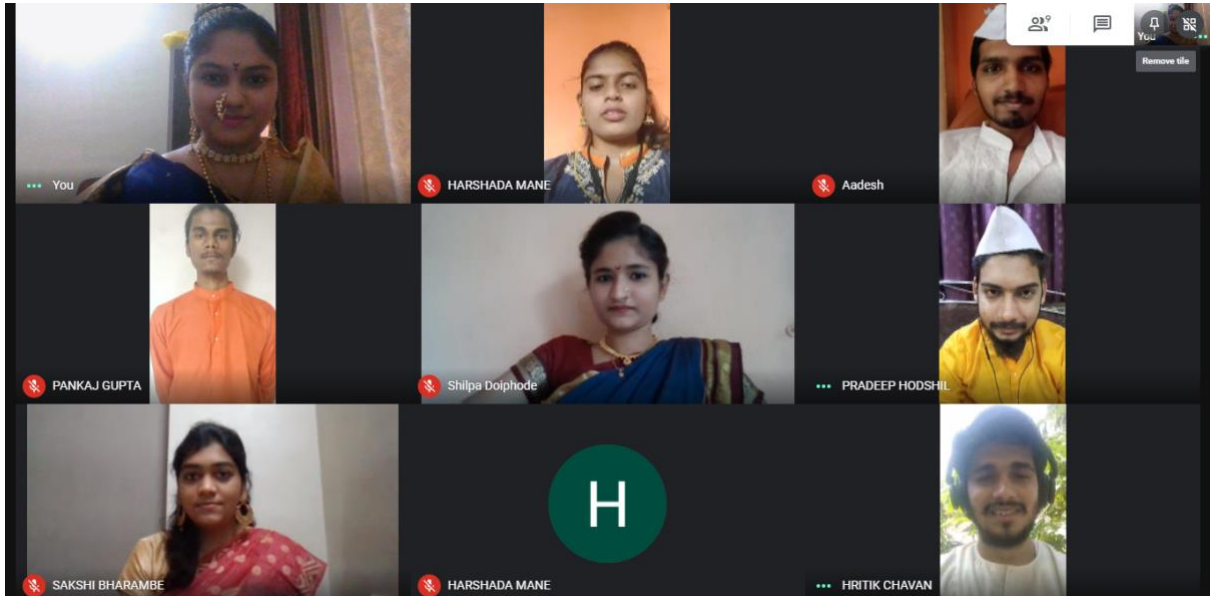

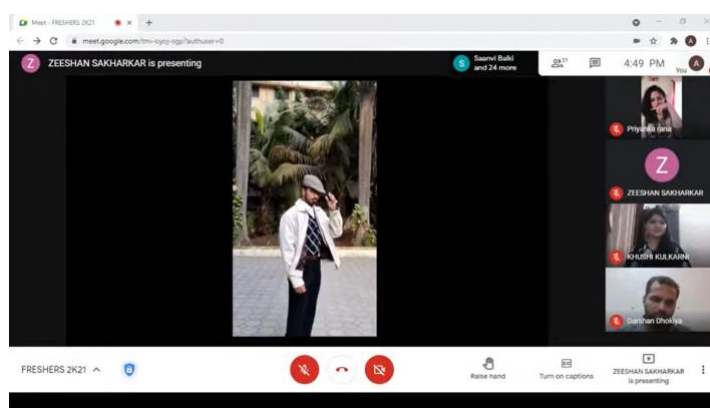
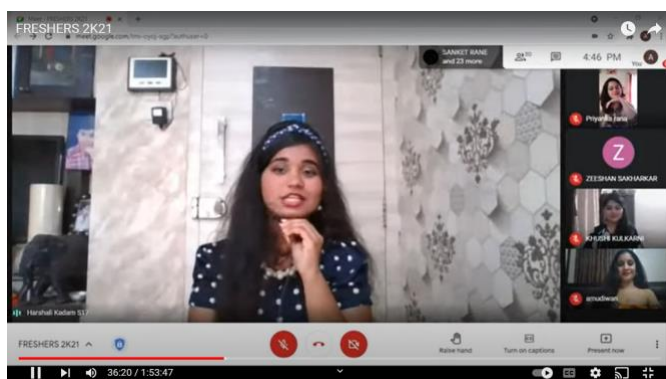


Freshers Party 2021

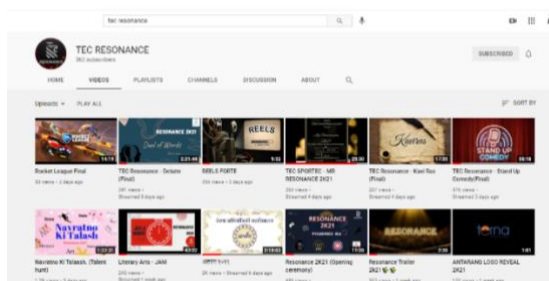


Date: 19 June,2021 to 22June,2021.

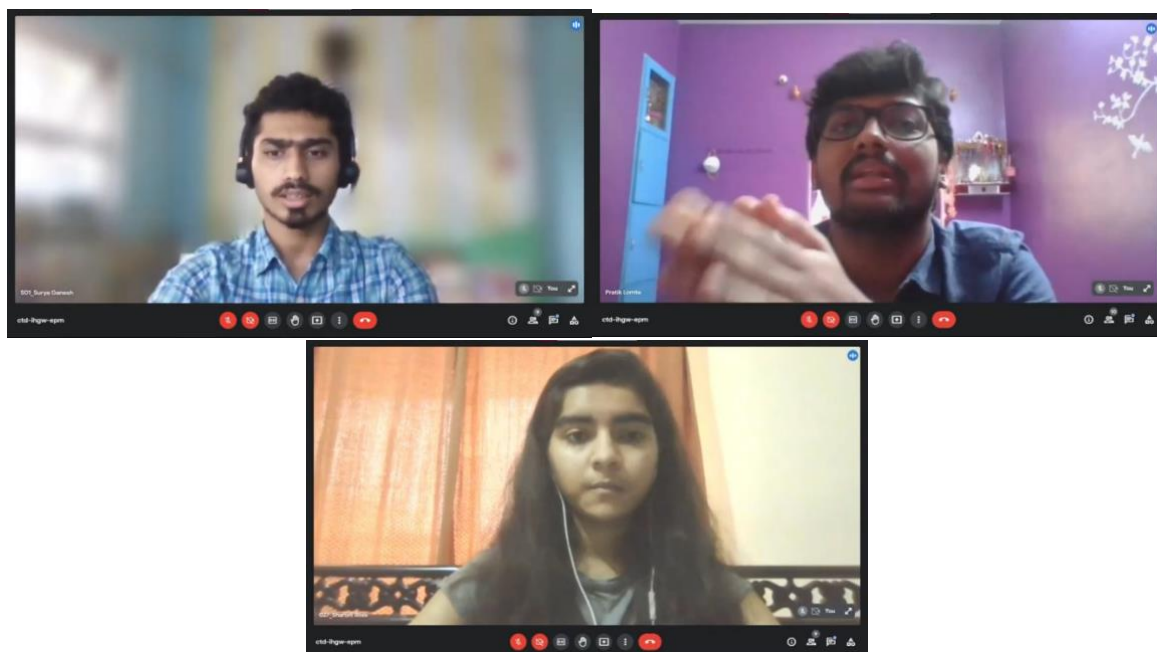


Just A Minute

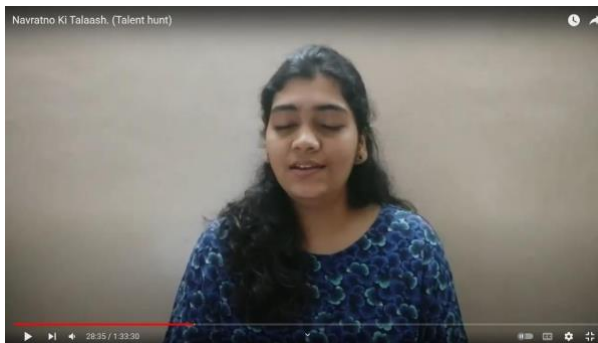


Navratno Ki Talash

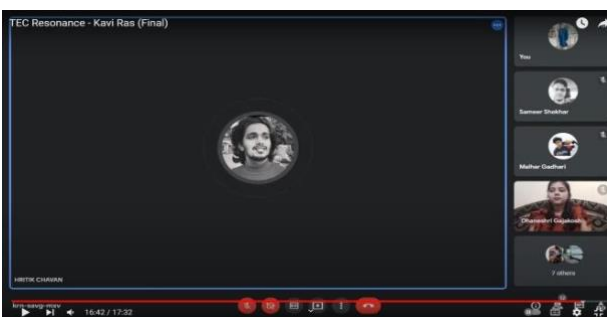


Kaviras

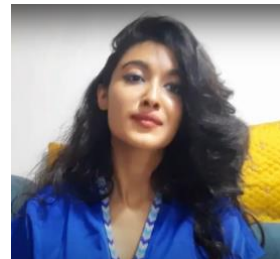


Reel Forte

Independence Day Celebration 2021

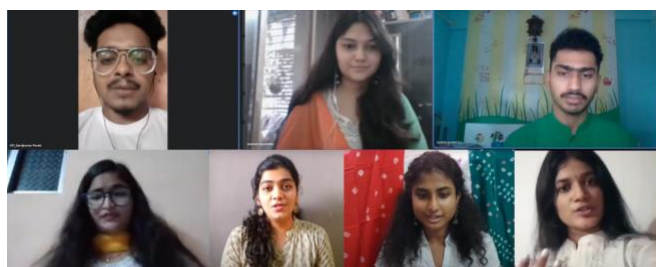
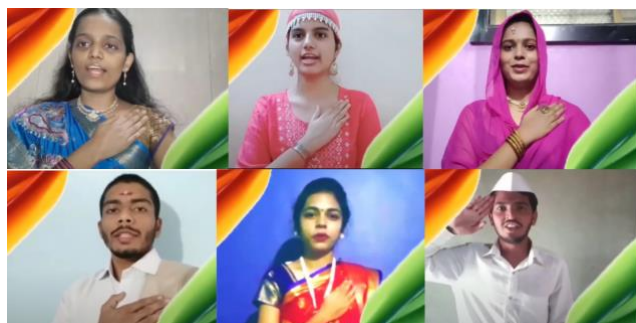
Date: 15 August, 2021.
